Sr. Gabriel Tamburri, C.S.JB. passed to her eternal reward at Providence Rest Nursing Home in the Bronx, on Friday, December 2, 2011. The Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated for her on Monday, December 5, 2011 at Providence Rest Chapel, Bronx, New York. Sister was interred at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Westchester, NY.

Sister was born in Castelpetroso-Campobasso, Italy, in 1922, and came to the United States in 1947. She was assigned to the Community's boarding school/orphanage at St. Lucy's Parish/School, Newark, New Jersey. Sister Gabriel ministered there for the next fifty years. Sister was a "mother" to many of the girls in the boarding school, assisted in the convent, and worked in the parish.

Sister Gabriel was a dedicated religious who faithfully fulfilled her ministerial and communal responsibilities and brought joy to all she knew especially the girls she cared for and loved for so many years.

In 2001, Sister Gabriel retired to our convent at Mt. St. John, Purchase, New York.

Needing greater physical care, Sister came to reside at Providence Rest Nursing Home, Bronx, NY in 2006.
